


### Introduction

The first successful co-op was formed in 1844 in Rochdale. At that time, living conditions in northern industrial towns were tough. Flour, sugar, butter and oats were expensive. Often, milk was watered down and mill owners mixed their flour with sawdust to increase their profits.

A group of 28 working-class men decided to change this. They raised the funds to set up a co-operative shop that provided good quality products to the community, at a fair price.

The Rochdale Pioneers as they are now commonly known spurred on a movement that has spread throughout the world and continues to thrive today.

Rochdale Development Agency is the local economic development agency for the borough of Rochdale established in 1993.



#### Location

Rochdale is a gateway to regional and global markets as one of the best located and connected destinations in the North of England.

There are six trains an hour to Manchester which is just 15 minutes away. In the opposite direction, four trains an hour take passengers to Leeds in 70 minutes. There are five stations in the borough, used by 2.3 million passengers every year.

Rochdale itself benefits from five direct links to the motorway network.

Centrally located on the M62, this motorway of over 100 miles links the ports of Liverpool and Hull as well as three of the top five largest urban areas in England; Manchester, Liverpool and Leeds.




## Why Choose Rochdale

Fast connections to the motorway network alongside frequent train, tram and bus services helping make Rochdale an ideal location for businesses.




## Why Choose Rochdale
